

Liberal Studies Major 2009-10

The following advising guide is intended for to students who have completed or are working towards an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree.

Students who have completed the AAOT will have completed all Lower Division General Education (Baccalaureate Core) requirements for the Liberal Studies major.

Students may consider taking the following courses while completing the AAOT to be best prepared for transfer to the Liberal Studies program.

- Students pursuing a **Bachelor of Science** in Liberal Studies should incorporate the following courses while completing the AAOT:
 - One of the following Math options in addition to the Math requirement for the AAOT (for other possibilities see your advisor)
 - 1) MTH 243, 244
 - 2) MTH 211, 212, 213*COCC requires all 3 for the AAOT completion (only for students with a Pre-Education theme/ plan of study)
 - 3) MTH 251, 252
 - 4) MTH 111, 243 (if Math 105 is taken for the Math Bacc Core requirement)
 - 1 additional science course from the AAOT Science Distribution List (see your advisor for the list)
 - Only including BI, BOT, CH, FOR, FW, G, GS, PH
 - Any Computer Information Systems course at least 100 level or above.
 - CIS 120 from COCC (required for the AAOT) satisfies this requirement, however if a student chooses to take the Computer Competency Test, they will still need to fulfill this requirement.

- Students pursuing a **Bachelor of Arts** in Liberal Studies should take the following courses:
 - Complete second year proficiency at level 203 with a C- or better in a foreign language.

Students may transfer to OSU-Cascades prior to completing the AAOT to receive advising toward the Liberal Studies major. Please check the OSU-Cascades Admissions website for admission criteria if you are not currently admitted to OSU-Cascades.

Important Numbers:

- 180—total number of credits required to graduate from OSU
- 60—number of upper division credits required
- 124—maximum number of credits which can be transferred from a community college
- 45 of last 75 credits must be OSU credits
- Maintain a 2.0 or better university and 2.3 major GPA

- It is the student's responsibility to make certain that all prerequisites are met or instructor permission is granted for courses that require one or both of these conditions.
- It is the responsibility of the student to continuously audit his/her program for successful completion of requirements.
