- No more than 6 credits from PS 401-PS 406, or PS 408-PS 410 may be applied to the minor.

Political Science Minor: A Degree Overview

The Department of Political Science at OSU in Corvallis offers course work leading to a political science major in several fields including: American politics, public policy, public law, public administration, political theory, state and local government, international relations, and comparative politics (for example, Asian Politics, Latin America, Western Europe, countries of the former Soviet Union). **An undergraduate minor is available at the OSU-Cascades Campus.**

Either directly, or after graduate study, political science graduates pursue degrees in law, foreign service, public management (all levels of government), policy analysis, international organizations, journalism, university teaching, research, political office and -- as with many other liberal arts graduates -- in business.
