The schedule for commencement is as follows:

CHECK-IN:	1:00 P.M. Saturday, June 13 Harmon Park baseball field
COMMENCEMENT:	2:00 P.M. Saturday, June 13 Drake Park
RECEPTION:	Immediately following Commencement Drake Park

AT CHECK-IN

Graduates: Bring or wear your regalia – be ready to walk. At check-in you will be given your line location and the seating chart. Graduates are seated by institution/degree/major. Once you have checked-in you are free to meet family and friends, take pictures, etc., in the check-in area.

SEATING WILL BE LIMITED!

We are expecting another large crowd this year. Tell your guests to come early if they want to be guaranteed a seat.

RAIN...OR SHINE

The commencement ceremony will take place at Drake Park – rain or shine. Bring your umbrellas if the forecast calls for rain. You and your guests will want to bring sunglasses, sunscreen and water if the forecast calls for clear skies.

REGALIA

All regalia is currently on sale in the COCC Bookstore.

HOODS FOR OSU MASTERS STUDENTS

Hoods will be available in early June. Master's students will be notified when they arrive. Bring your hood to the Masters check-in/line up area in Mazama gym.

HONOR CORDS (OSU Undergraduate Students)

If you are graduating with honors, we will receive your honor cord and will give it to you at the time of check-in.

PARKING

You may park on the west side of the river in any valid parking spots. There is also limited parking on the east side of the river. Please assist us by parking in suggested areas.

There will be assisted drop off for guests with disabilities on Riverside Drive. There will be signs on the street to direct you to the drop off area.
