OSU-Cascades Campus offers a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree with an option in Fine Art. The curriculum provides an awareness and understanding of the historical and contemporary significance of art as a unique feature of society.

The OSU-Cascades Art program offers the opportunity for professional artistic development while incorporating subjects that lead to a liberal education. These major programs prepare the student for a range of professional opportunities or later graduate study in graphic design, advertising, communications, photography, fine art, and art history.
