**OSU Graduation Requirements:**

**180 total credits, 60 credits must be Upper Division (300-400 level)**

**45 out of last 75 credits must be OSU**

**\*Students interested in pursuing the BFA degree must meet with Lead Faculty of program for approval and portfolio review.**

**\*A minimum of 3.00 GPA must be maintained in all art courses to meet BFA requirements.**

**\*Students may not use courses in which they have earned less than a C- to satisfy BFA requirements**

**\*Students may not use Art or Art History Courses for Baccalaureate Core**

**\*Art majors and minors may NOT take required Art courses on an S/U basis.**
