Important Numbers:

Art: A Program Overview

OSU-Cascades Campus offers a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree with an option in Fine Art. The curriculum provides an awareness and understanding of the historical and contemporary significance of art as a unique feature of society.

The OSU-Cascades Art program offers the opportunity for professional artistic development while incorporating subjects that lead to a liberal education. These major programs prepare the student for a range of professional opportunities or later graduate study in graphic design, advertising, communications, photography, fine art, and art history.

Baccalaureate Core (total 48 credits)

Oregon community college students entering OSU-Cascades Fall term 1990 or thereafter, having completed the Associate of Arts (AA) degree meeting the OUS-Oregon Community College block transfer agreement will automatically have satisfied all the lower-division requirements of the Baccalaureate Core's Skills and Perspective categories.

Some classes at OSU are taught with an honor's designation (H). Some classes at COCC may be taught with an M, W, or MW designation. As long as the course number is the same, this course will meet the requirement. For example, COCC may teach HUM 210 as either HUM 210, HUM 210MW or HUM 210W. All of these options will fulfill the Literature and Arts requirement.
