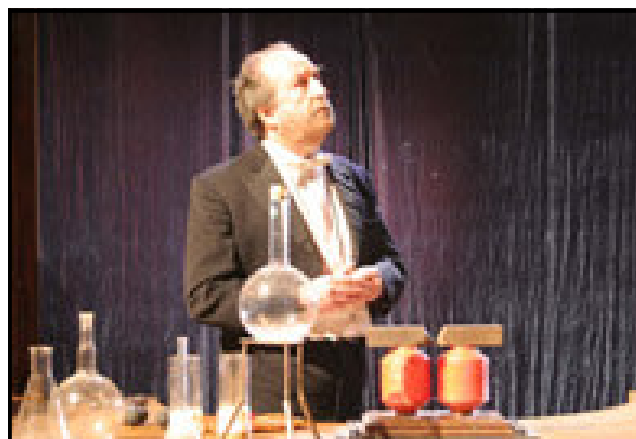
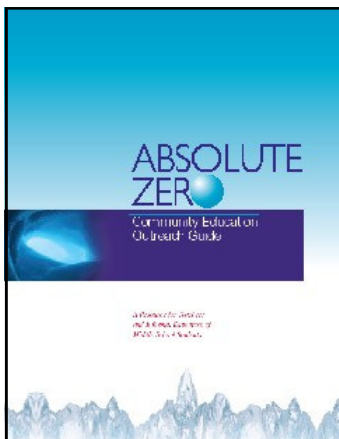


The Making of Absolute Zero
