What is ASCC?

Associated Students of Cascades Campus is the official student government of OSU-Cascades Campus. Fall 2007 will be the first official term, so you will be blazing the trail for students to come. You need to be a go-getter, with a desire to represent students' interests and enhance the student experience at OSU-Cascades. ASCC members need to be committed to serving OSU-Cascades by building a diverse community, supporting creativity, and encouraging learning. It is a great resume-builder and will give you hands-on experience with event planning, budgeting, teamwork and public administration.

We are recruiting **4 ASCC positions: President, Vice-President, Secretary Treasurer and Activities Coordinator**. Students will be appointed for a minimum of 3 terms (fall, winter, spring). These are paid positions, 5 hours a week @ \$10/hr. You must be admitted to OSU-Cascades and be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits per term. You must also maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

To Apply

Fill out an ASCC application form. Attach all supporting documents including a petition with 25 OSU-Cascades student signatures and ID #s (see form on application).

Qualified applicants will be invited to a selection interview with the selection committee. The selection committee will consist of one student from each program of study at Cascades.

Application Deadline: APRIL 30th, 5:00 pm

What is the Student Fee Committee?

The Student Fee Committee is the official committee which allocates the incidental fee monies collected each term from students. If you are interested in learning where the money goes and making tough decisions on allocations which enhance the student experience at OSU-Cascades, then the SFC is for you. SFC members need to be committed to serving OSU-Cascades by building a diverse community, supporting creativity, and encouraging learning through the allocation of student funds. Serving on the SFC is a great resume-builder and will give you hands-on experience with budgeting, consensus decision-making, teamwork and public administration.

We are recruiting **4-5 new SFC members for the 2007-08 academic year**. These are paid positions, 1-2 hours a week @ \$10/hr., with a maximum of 15 hours per term. During winter term budget hearings, those hours will increase somewhat. You must be admitted to OSU-Cascades and be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits per term.

To Apply

Fill out an SFC application form. Attach all supporting documents. Qualified applicants will be invited to an interview with the current Student Fee Committee, who will select the members for next year.
