

TOL Curriculum Guide (New Program) Outdoor and Experiential Education Option

All required College of Forestry courses (or substitutes for them) must be completed with a grade of C- or higher. S/U grading cannot be used for courses meeting major requirements (it can be used in Bacc Core courses). Students must meet the following program requirements and have at least 180 credits for the BS in TOL.

This must include 60 upper division (UD) credits; 45 of the last 75 credits must be OSU credits. Any student not meeting the OSU foreign language admissions requirement must complete two terms of the same college-level foreign language with a grade of C- or higher.
