

BEND CHAPTER OHA CHARLES BECKLEY SCHOLARSHIP

The Bend Chapter of the Oregon Hunters Association (OHA) has established a scholarship for higher education honoring long-time life member Charles Beckley, who passed away in 2004. Chuck was a dedicated OHA member who was among the first hunter-education instructors in the state. Establishing this scholarship will further our goal of helping to educate future hunters in Oregon.

The Scholarship amount will be \$1000 for 2008. Funds are raised through a special auction/raffle at our Mule Deer Classic banquet each year and are placed in a dedicated fund to be used for future Beckley Scholarship awards.

Rules:

1. The Scholarship will be available to all new or returning college students enrolled in any accredited trade school, technical school, community college or university.
2. The scholarship funds will be sent directly to the school at which the student is enrolled in their name.
3. The scholarship award is for one year only and must be used during the school year immediately following its award. Any unused funds will be returned to the Scholarship fund to be used for future awards.
4. Applicants must complete the Scholarship application form, including essay, and submit both to the Bend Chapter, OHA by May 15th, 2008.
5. A recipient may apply for the Scholarship each year; however, the award will be selected from all applicants each year.
6. The applicant must be a member of OHA's Bend Chapter.

Selection Criteria:

Applications will be judged based on eligibility requirements and on the essay submitted as part of the application. Applications will be reviewed, and the awardee selected, by the Bend OHA Officers and Directors.
