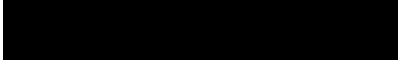

Advising for Fall Term

If you've been procrastinating all summer about registering for classes, now is the time to roll up your sleeves and prepare yo

Your first step in planning a schedule will be to review your program requirements. If you've lost your checklist or are thinking go to <http://www.osucascades.edu/advising/guides.php/#Majors> for downloadable advising guides to all OSU-Cascades major you know what you need to complete, take a look at the schedule for fall term at <http://www.osucascades.edu/advising/class>. Next, schedule a meeting with your academic advisor. This person will need to get you your OSU PIN number and/or clear a before you can register. If you're forgotten who your advisor is, go to <http://www.osucascades.edu/advising/contacts.php> for a program. Remember that many faculty advisors are not on campus during the summer months. If you are having any problem 322-3100 to be scheduled with a general advisor. Regardless of whomever you work with, remember to bring the following w appointment: 1) Your program checklist filled out to the best of your ability, 2) Notes from previous meetings with your advisor the next term, and 4) A list of questions that you have.
