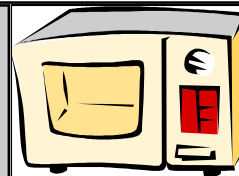
Check out the new Warren Miller film, "Off the Grid", and visit the expo for the latest gear and info on the snow scene in Central Oregon.

Do you need money? Want a flexible work schedule? Need to fit in a few hours of work between classes? Want to work with the fun faculty & staff?

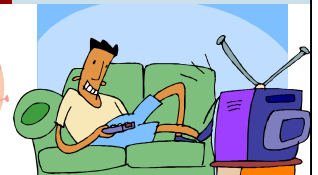

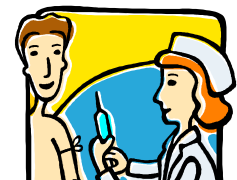
Immunization Forms

For those of you who haven't yet sent in your immunization forms, do so before winter registration begins in November or there may be a registration hold on your account. State law requires proof of 1) two measles shots, or 2) a recent booster shot, or 3) a test which shows elevated immunization levels. If you are having difficulty with any of these

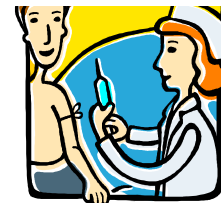
